

## **Statement on the Collection and Use of Personal Data**

KON-2K5 d.o.o. is obliged to provide personal data protection by collecting only the essential, basic customer/consumer information required to meet our obligations. All customer information is strictly kept and only accessible to employees who are required to do this. All employees of KON-2K5 d.o.o. and business partners are responsible for adhering to the privacy principles.

This statement commits us to protect the privacy of our users, customers, and visitors of our site and the security of personal information provided to us through the website.

This notice describes the type of information we can collect from you when you visit our website and explains how we use these data and the steps we take to protect them. The notice also describes the choices you have about collecting and using your information when visiting our website.

What information do we collect about you and how do we use it?

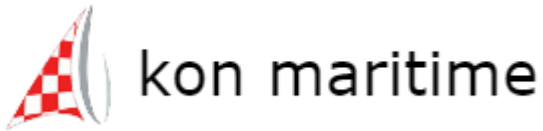

### **Statement of Confidentiality**

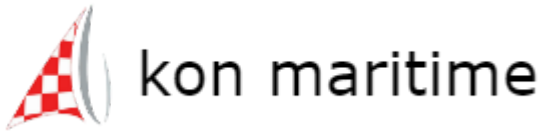

The collected personal data will be used by KON-2K5 d.o.o. as used to send and distribute ordered goods, etc.

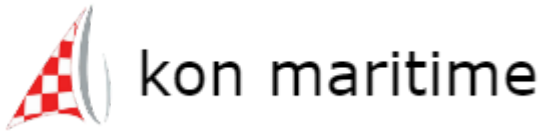

## **What are cookies?**

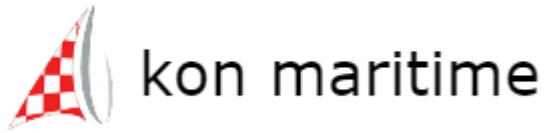
